

ASMSA Summer 2008 Enrichment Day Camps For Students Grades 6-9

9 Days: June 23-27 and June 30-July 3

9:00-4:00 each day



German/French Taster (Grades 6-9): The German/French Taster day camp will teach students high-frequency vocabulary in speaking, listening, and writing activities in both/either language(s). Students will role play, engage in physical activities, make authentic food, and generally “get a taste” of the target language. This camp will be 9 days in length and be taught by ASMSA Humanities Faculty. Tuition: \$300.00

International Potpourri (Grades 6-9): The International Potpourri Day Camp will engage students in the language, literature, foods, and arts/crafts of at least 5 nations represented by the people who live in Arkansas. Students will learn songs, make authentic food and crafts, learn basic words of 5 languages, and interact with native speakers. This camp will be 9 days in length and be taught by ASMSA Humanities Faculty. Tuition: \$300.00

Math Day Camp for grades 8-9: The goal for the ASMSA Math Day Camp is to provide a safe learning environment in which students will be exposed to fascinating mathematics and statistics topics that are typically not covered in a traditional class. For example, students will be introduced to conic sections with an emphasis on the parabola, by making a satellite dish. The camp will be 9 days in length and will be taught by ASMSA Mathematics Faculty. Tuition: \$300.00

Science of Music (Grades 8-9): The Science of Music Day Camp will provide a safe learning environment in which students will investigate the mathematics and science involved in designing, building, and playing a mandolin, guitar, or dulcimer. At the end of the nine-day Science of Music Day Camp, students will have gained an appreciation and understanding of advanced mathematics and science topics, be able to demonstrate this understanding, will have built a musical instrument, and will be able to play their instrument. This camp will be 9 days in length and be taught by ASMSA Science and Humanities Faculty. Tuition: \$400.00
